WELCOME to VANCOUVER



School Location:

Pera College is located in the heart of downtown Vancouver in beautiful British Columbia, Canada. We are at the fringe of Historic Gastown (the original old part of Vancouver) and only one block away from Waterfront Station which serves as the main terminal for Translink buses, Skytrain, Sea Bus, and West Coast Express. There are also bus stops right in front of the campus. We are within walking distance or a short bus ride to many places of interest such as shopping malls, parks, gardens, beaches, art galleries, museums, movie houses, sports and concert stadiums, places of worship, shopping places, and more.

Visitor Visas and Student Visas (Study permit):

Citizens of some countries such as Germany, Italy, Japan, Korea, and Spain do not need visas to study in Canada for less than six months. However, citizens from other countries are required to have Temporary Residents visas to enter Canada. Study Permits are not required for courses lasting six months or less. If your program is longer than six months, you must apply for a study permit at the closest Canadian embassy or consulate before coming to Canada. You cannot obtain a study permit from within Canada. You must obtain one in your country of origin before you come.

How To Register:

The first step is to choose your Program and complete your signed application form (download from the web site), and submit it to PERA College by post, fax or email (scanned copy will be fine). Please send your Deposit of \$1,500 (CAD\$) by Bank Wire to PERA College (for bank details view www.peracollege.com). Your deposit will be applied to your tuition fees. Upon receipt of payment, you will be sent a Letter of Acceptance which you will need to obtain your student or tourist entry visa. Once you obtain your student or tourist entry visa, the balance of your fees are due.

Planning:

Before applying for a study permit you must have:

- * valid passport
- * letter of acceptance from a Canadian school
- * proof that you can financially support your entire stay in Canada
- * letter from your sponsoring organization if you are being sponsored.
- * medical clearance, if required
- * application fee
